

BASE INFORMATION (continued)

The NWS Earle RV Park offers large roomy sites with 10 X 62-foot concrete pads, 11 X 25-foot patios, easy access from a paved roadway. Set on a grassy and wooded knoll, the park is in a secluded and quiet area of the base.

All sites have full water and sewer hook-ups, 20, 30 and 50 amp electric service, a picnic table and barbecue grill. Computers are available at C-29 with online access. Cell phones are recommended.

All sites are back-in with easy access and room maneuverability. Units must be self-contained. Pets must be well-behaved, licensed and have up-to-date immunizations. Pets are not to be left alone either inside or outside RV. If determined to be a nuisance to other campers, there are several pet boarding facilities located within a short distance.

Located on beautifully wooded acres in the township of Colts Neck, Monmouth County, MWR's RV facilities are within driving, ferry, train or bus distance

to New York, Atlantic City, Philadelphia, Six Flags, and Atlantic Ocean beaches. For history buffs, there are many Revolutionary War sites and memorials in the area, as well as pastoral lands.

Monmouth Park--a premiere horse race facility and Wall Stadium--a NASCAR track, are within eight miles.

For lighthouse buffs, historic Twin Lights--once the brightest beacon on the east coast and Sandy Hook Lighthouse--the oldest continuously operating lighthouse in the United States, are within 10 miles. Barnegat, "Old Barney," and Cape May lighthouses are within an hours drive.

NWS Earle offers a fitness center, gymnasium, computers with online capability and a library for RVers. ITT offers discounted tickets and transportation to events in the tri-state area.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

Shopping

There are two malls, both anchored by major department stores, within five miles of the main gate. An outlet mall, featuring brand name shops is about 20 miles away.

Theater

Live theater, dinner, dessert and amateur theaters along with high school and college presentations are all available within 20 miles. The base is 30 minutes away from the New Brunswick theater and cultural arts district, and an hour's drive from Princeton theaters and concerts. The PNC Bank Arts Center at the Garden State Parkway, exit 116, offers top talent and entertainment (summer months only).

Birding

Both Sandy Hook and Cape May are on the eastern flyway and noted for the numerous bird species identified both year round and during migratory periods.

Fishing

Both fresh water (with a New Jersey state license) and salt water fishing are available in the area. Monmouth County beaches offer some of the finest surf fishing on the East Coast, and numerous party and charter boats sail from ports within 18 miles of the main gate for half-day, full-day and overnight excursions.

Swimming

Gateway National Recreation Area offers beaches on both the ocean and Shrewsbury River at Sandy Hook and is located 15 miles from the main gate. Seven Presidents Park is a County ocean beach six miles distant. A YMCA with a pool and health facilities is located in Red Bank six miles distant.
