PIER FISHING RULES

ANNUAL PASS

\$20 for all military
\$30 for DoD civilians

FIVE-DAY PASS

\$5 for all military
and DoD civilians

Fishing is permitted from the front of the pier to the elbow and only in the areas designated by the safety cable on the north (left) side of the pier. **NO FISHING ON THE SOUTH (RIGHT) SIDE OF THE PIER OR PAST THE BEND.**

1. **ALL VIRGINIA STATE AND FEDERAL FISHING REGULATIONS MUST BE OBSERVED.**
2. Only authorized personnel listed below may fish from the pier.
 - a. Active duty, retirees, reservists and family members.
 - b. DoD personnel (current and retired)
 - c. Guests of the above
3. Authorized persons must possess a current CAX Sportsman's Pass. The permit allows the holder up to **TWO ADULT** guests (or immediate family members) to fish from the pier. There must be two adults on the pier to fish. **ALL PERSONS MUST CHECK IN AT THE MAIN GATE BEFORE USING PIER.** Personnel fishing from or traveling on the CAX Supply Pier do so at their own risk.
4. Fishing hours are Monday to Friday from 4 p.m. to 6 a.m. and 24 hours on Saturday and Sunday. The pier may be closed at any given time, without notice, for operations or weather conditions.
5. Driving on the pier is prohibited. Security staff may authorize exceptions for severely handicapped or disabled persons. The pier parking lot is located at the intersection of Sanda Avenue and Point Road.
6. Adults are responsible for their children. Children 13 and younger must be accompanied by an adult.
7. Children **WILL NOT** be left unattended in vehicles. Baby carriages, play pens, etc. are not permitted on the pier.
8. If someone falls off the pier, shout "MAN OVERBOARD" until assistance arrives. Obtain a life ring from the nearest hanger on the safety rail and pull the nearest fire alarm box. Boxes are located at the elbow of the pier, midway between the elbow and the shore at the fish hut and on the telephone pole at the end of the pier. There is a pay phone located at the elbow of the pier.
9. **LITTERING is absolutely prohibited (including fishing line) and can be cause for permanent revocation of pier pass.**
10. Consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited. Violation of any rule can result in a loss of fishing privileges/removal from pier.
